

# ATCA Blue Skies Initiative – Strategic House

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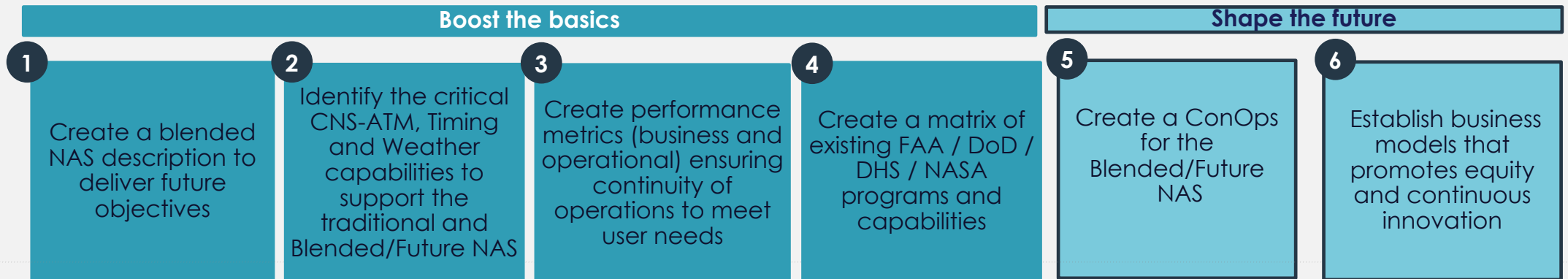
## Vision
